## PRIVATE MUSIC LESSONS

Our skilled and talented teachers provide the highest quality musical education and inspire artistry in their students. With over 40 music teachers on faculty, we offer year-round private music lessons in a wide variety of instruments to students of all ages and abilities. Private music lessons are available during the day, after school, in the evening and on weekends. Generally, lessons run from September to June; however, many of our teachers offer lessons through the summer months as well.

Our welcoming facility boasts well-equipped studios and performance spaces that enhance learning and encourage music making.

Aside from regular private music instruction, we offer many additional opportunities for students to hone their technical and performance skills:

### Master Classes

Every spring we host master classes with guest teachers for our students. These group classes allow our students to receive feedback from specialists and learn from watching the master presenter give feedback to fellow students.

### Faculty Concerts

Place des Arts' music teachers perform in faculty concerts throughout the year. These concerts are wonderful opportunities for students to learn from watching and listening to their teachers play.

### Student Concerts

Place des Arts' students have many opportunities to perform themselves. Monthly student concerts, art openings and other special events are just some of the performance opportunities we provide. Many of our teachers also hold studio recitals in which their students are invited to perform.

### MR I'S MUSICAL RAINBOW

Musical Rainbow provides musicianship training for children aged three years to grade three. Through singing songs, chanting rhymes, playing music games, using xylophones, recorders and other instruments, children learn the principles of music. This program is based on the Kodály philosophy of using songs and rhymes from children's folk culture, along with elements of Orff and Suzuki methodology. Note reading, writing and music history are taught in the upper levels. Mr. I's Musical Rainbow provides a solid basic understanding of music and may inspire your child to take private instrument lessons at an older age.

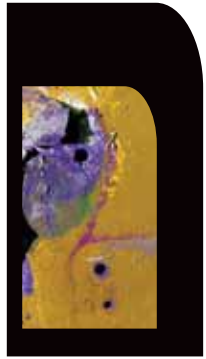
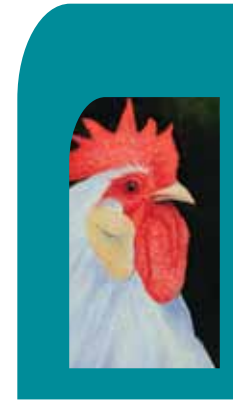

## SCHOLARSHIP AND BURSARY AWARDS

Place des Arts awards annual scholarships and bursaries to help students in their pursuit of excellence in the visual, literary and performing arts. Scholarships are awarded to students in recognition of artistic excellence or achievement. Bursaries are awarded based on financial need.

### PLACE DES ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Every year, Place des Arts awards scholarships based on artistic excellence and achievement (individual and group) or for overcoming a personal challenge. These scholarships are open to students age 10 and up who are registered in music, dance, theatre, literary or visual arts classes at Place des Arts.

### SCHOLARSHIP FOR ADVANCED MUSICAL STUDIES

Place des Arts Scholarship for Advanced Musical Studies is awarded annually and is open to all Place des Arts music students working toward their grade 10 or ARCT (or equivalent) levels. This award helps offset the high expense of senior musical studies and provides students with an extra incentive to continue with their music education.

### CMHT AWARD

The CMHT Award is an annual award founded in recognition of the Coquitlam-Maillardville Heritage Trust's generous contributions to the Place des Arts Endowment Fund. The CMHT award will benefit a promising student at Place des Arts who demonstrates financial need and resides in the city of Coquitlam.

### LEONORE PEYTON MEMORIAL AWARD

This award was established in memory of Leonore Peyton, former Place des Arts Executive Director and founding member.

### ELLIOTT HARTY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Place des Arts established this scholarship to honour the memory of piano student Elliott Harty. Each year, it is awarded to the Place des Arts piano student who shows the greatest improvement over the year.

### W.H. SCLATER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Born in New Westminster, Bill Sclater was well known for his adult and children's visual arts classes. This scholarship is presented annually to a student at Place des Arts in order to further his or her studies and growth in the field of visual arts.

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

### Sessional classes (fall, winter, spring)

Full payment of program fees must be made at the time of registration. Help ensure that programs will go ahead by registering early. If there is insufficient registration at least two working days prior to the start of a course, it may be cancelled. Supplies for classes should not be purchased by the student until a few days before the course start date to avoid unnecessary expenditures if the class is cancelled.

## REFUNDS, TRANSFERS AND WITHDRAWALS

### Workshops / Camps

1. No refunds or transfers will be granted. Exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons may be considered upon receipt of a written request at least 24 hours prior to the start of the camp/workshop. All refunds are subject to a \$10 processing fee and will not include supply fees.

### Sessional Classes

1. A full refund or transfer will be granted if a class is cancelled by Place des Arts.
2. A refund or transfer must be requested in writing at least seven calendar days prior to the start of a class. Upon approval, a refund of the course fee will be granted less a processing fee of \$10. No refunds or transfers will be granted after seven days before classes start.
3. After classes have started, no refunds or transfers will be granted. Exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons may be considered upon receipt of a written request. A medical certificate may be required. Upon approval, a refund of the remaining course fees will be granted less a processing fee of \$10 and applicable supply fees.

1. A student may cancel or transfer ongoing lessons with two paid lessons notice given to both Place des Arts and the teacher. Place des Arts will return any remaining post-dated cheques or payments once the two paid lessons notice period has lapsed.
