Summer Fun! offers everything you need: flexibility, choice, innovation, excellent instruction, after hours care and, of course, lots of summer fun!

This program is uniquely designed to allow you to fully customize your schedule and create a personalized summer program packed with your favourite arts activities.

Our 3-hour art intensives for 12-to-14-year-olds and our exciting 50-minute classes for 5-to-7 and 8-to-12-year-olds are developed with each age group in mind.

FOREST FUN: DRAMA

What's it like to grow from a seed into a giant tree? What's it like to grow up as an animal in the forest? Come and find out for yourself in drama class! We will nurture the growth of our very own imaginations, but mostly we will play drama games and have fun. Teacher: James O'Shea

GREENEST EARTH EVER

Make the Earth using sculpture, assemblage and montage. Use your imagination and knowledge to create the greenest Earth ever! Teacher: Mona Lochan

JUNGLE CLAYMATION

Sculpt your favourite forest or jungle animal out of modelling clay and then bring it to life in a claymation short, animated and voiced by you, then posted on YouTube for the world to see! Teacher: Kenten Bowick

LEAVES 'N STICKS

Create your own door decoration. Cut out leaf shapes from hand-woven cloth, and use fabric paints for surface designs. Stitch, embellish and attach your creative leaves to a curly branch to complete your project. Teacher: Irene Weisner

MIXED MEDIA RHINOS

Familiarize yourself with the most recognizable animal of the African safari: the Rhinoceros. Learn basic elements of proportion drawing, types of drawing and elements of visual composition: foreground-background, value, colour, shape and texture. Teacher: Stan Hunc

RAIN DANCE

Have you ever heard of the rain dance? We will create our own dance of the seasons to help the planet dance! Teacher: Kristen Pickell

RHYTHMS OF THE EARTH

Create soundscapes using hand drums, shakers, wood blocks, bells and whistles. Learn to make music inspired by sounds and places in nature. Be inspired by the rainforest, desert and arctic landscapes to beat out the rhythms of the earth. Teacher: Jason Overy

SING LIKE THE BIRDS: MUSICAL THEATRE

Join this fun introduction to the basics of musical theatre: singing, acting and dancing! Through games, exercises, techniques and our nature theme, you'll be singing like the birds as we explore a classic Broadway tune. Teacher: Shawna Parry

WACKY BUGS

Invent some wacky bugs while learning the basic principles of molding, shaping and sculpting clay. Please note that finished projects will not be fired or glazed. Teacher: Elaine Hansen
